

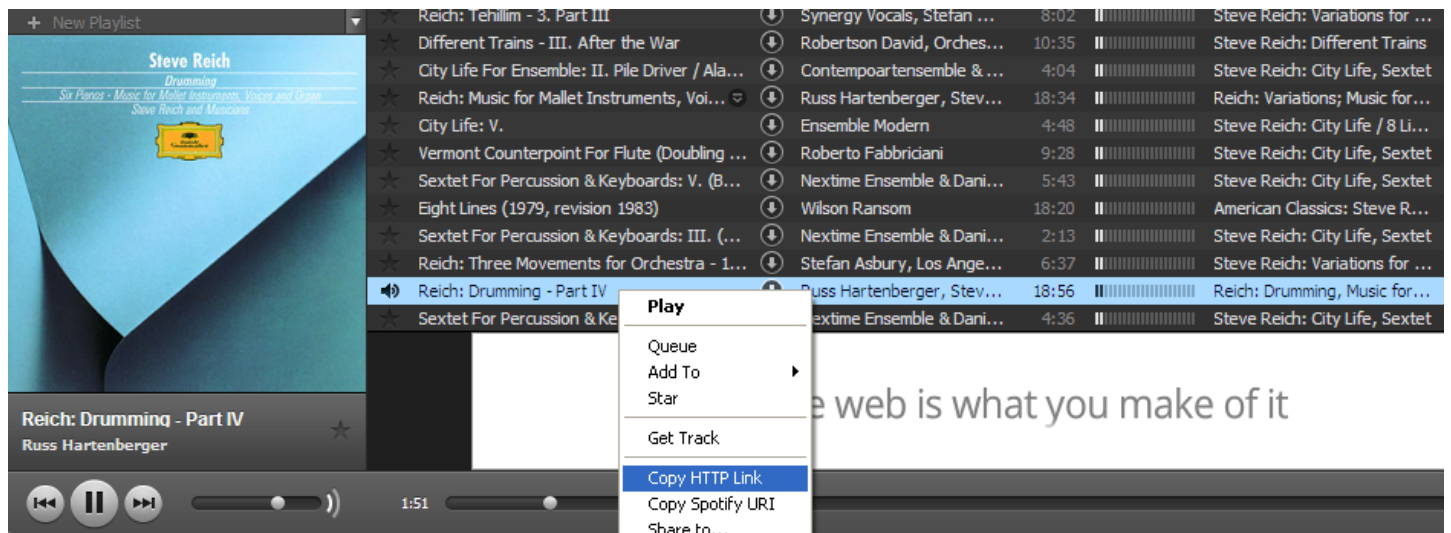
Linking to music on Spotify

If you don't have a Spotify account sign up at

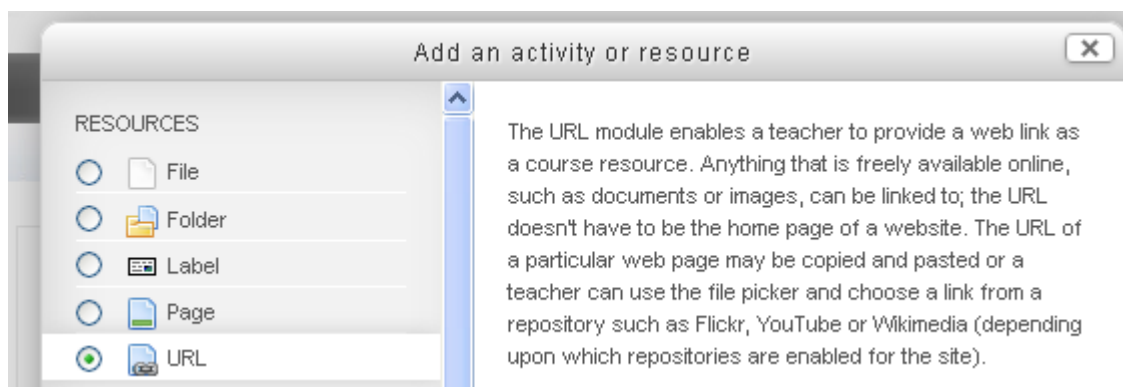
<http://www.spotify.com>

Follow the instructions on the website to install Spotify on your computer.

Once you have installed Spotify and found the track you want to link to, simply right click (if using Windows) or Control-Click (on a Mac) on the title of the track, and select 'Copy HTTP Link'



With editing turned on in Moodle simply add as a link by selecting 'URL' from the 'Add an activity or resource' pop-up and clicking on the 'Add' button.



Add a name for the link and paste the link into the 'External URL' box

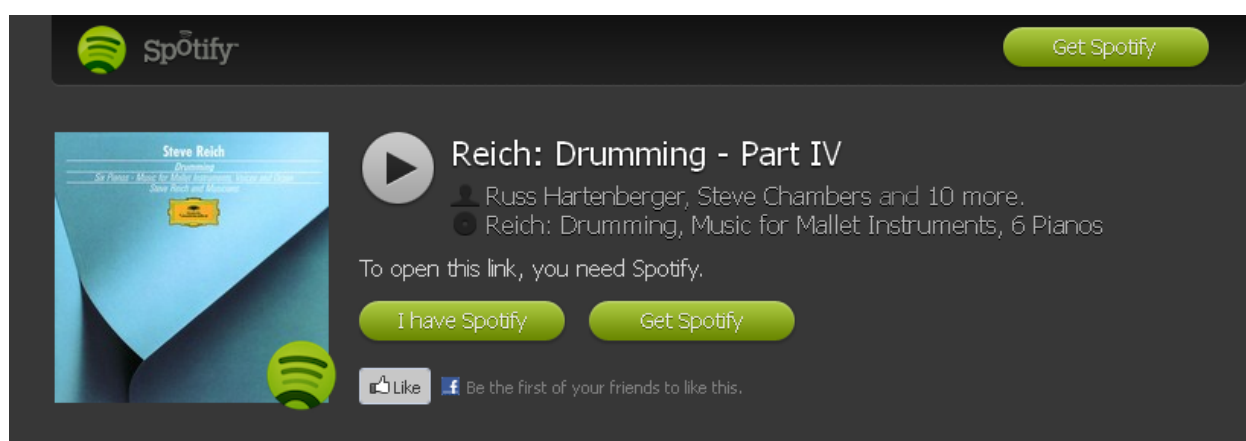
