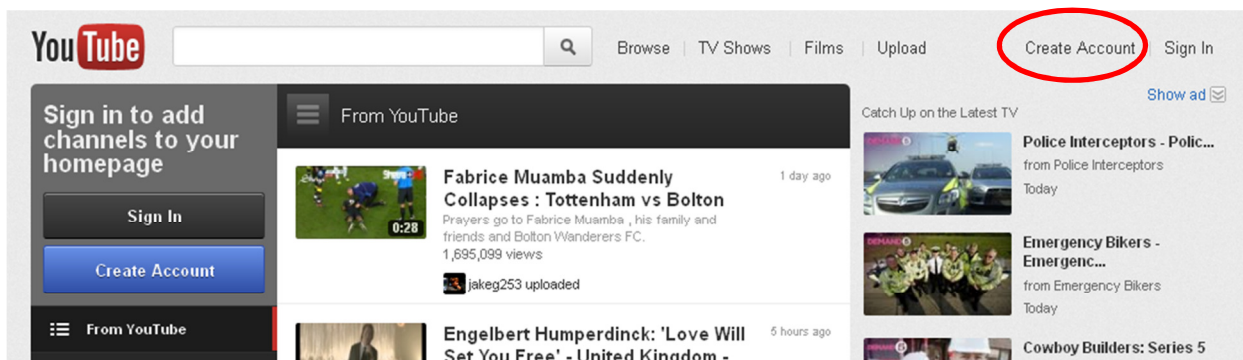


Setting up a YouTube account.

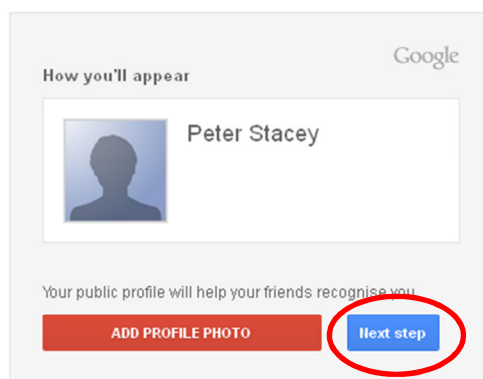
Fill in the details to create your account. The account will valid for all Google's services, not just YouTube. For instance you will get a Gmail email account as well.

Your profile

Your profile also lets you publicly "+1" things that you love on the web, so you and your friends can benefit from each other's impeccable taste in search results, on sites across the web, even on ads. 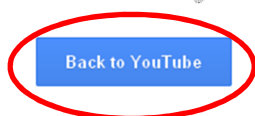
If you want to add a photo to your profile you can do it here, or just click on 'Next Step'

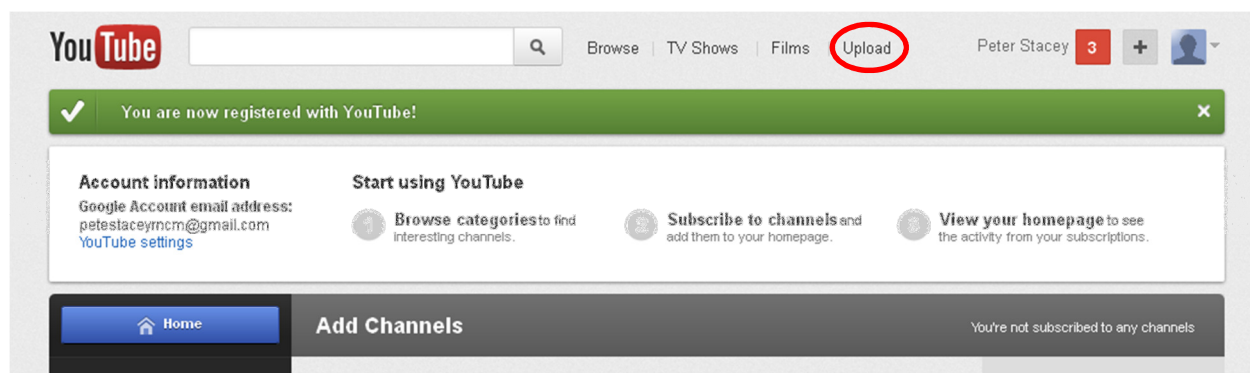


Your Google account is now set up! But you still need to finish setting up your YouTube specific settings.


Click on 'Upload'

You now have to set your YouTube username which sets the address that your YouTube channel will appear at. This doesn't really matter much for videos that will be linked through Moodle.

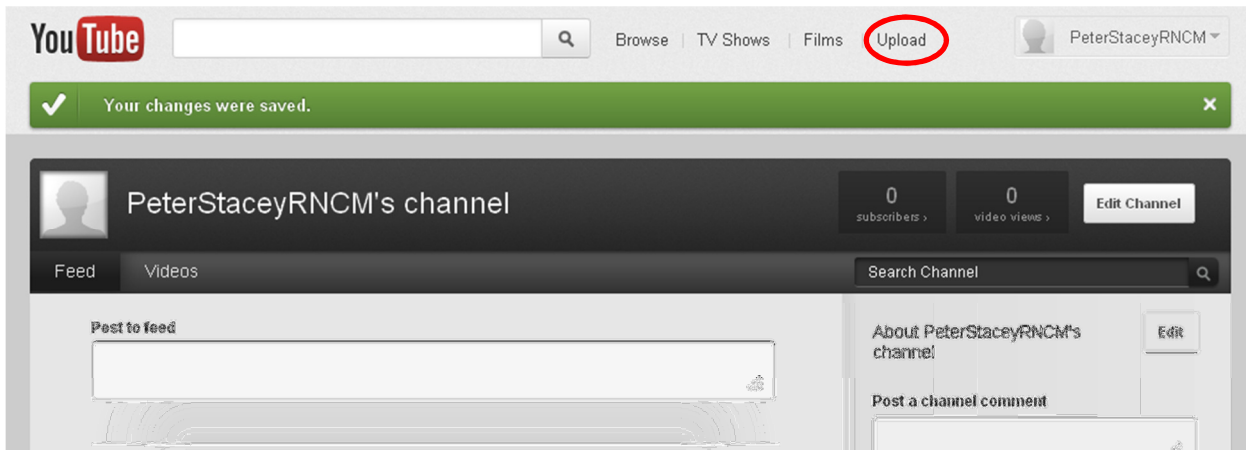
It is a good idea to uncheck the box next to 'Let others find my channel on YouTube if they have my email address' This will help to keep your videos private to you and the students you share them with through YouTube.

Click 'Finished!'



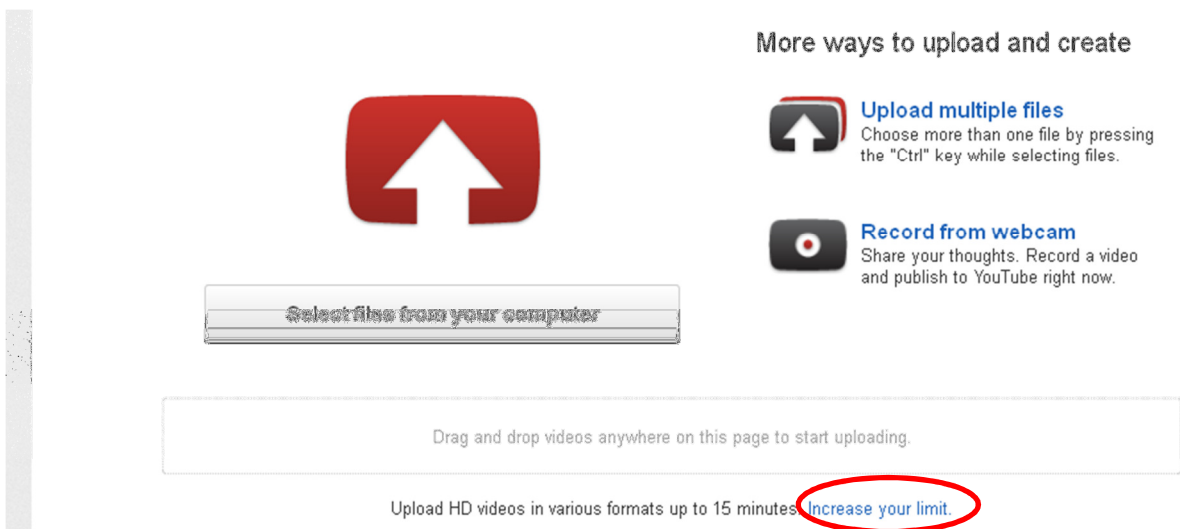
You have now set up your YouTube account. However, if you want to be able to upload videos more than 15 minutes long you have to go through a few more steps.

Part 3 – Enable uploading of longer videos


To allow you to upload videos of more than 15 minutes YouTube require you to 'verify' your account by giving them a valid mobile phone number and entering the code that they text to that number as detailed below.

N.B. YouTube will revoke this privilege if you break their terms by uploading copyright material!

Click on 'Upload' (again!)
