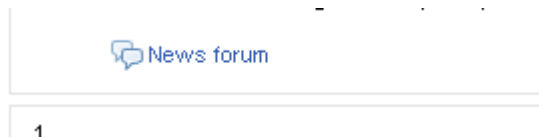


Posting an announcement in your Moodle course area

It is easy for tutors to post an announcement to all the students who are enrolled on your course in Moodle using the 'News forum' that is automatically provided for every course area.

It is not necessary to turn editing on, simply click on the 'News forum' link.


In Moodle, news announcements are just a specialised sort of discussion forum, so don't be confused when it refers to a 'forum' or a 'topic' when you are posting .



The News Forum page will then display

General news and announcements



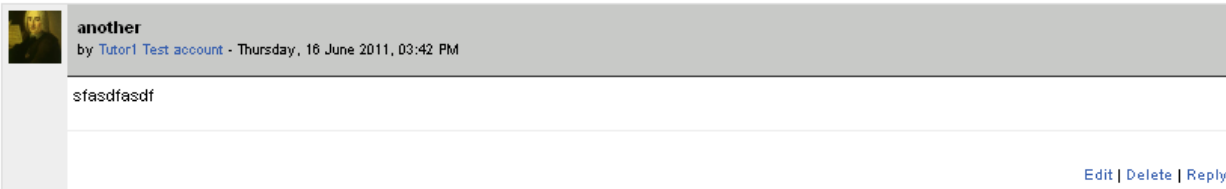

To add a new announcement just click on the 'Add a new topic' button

You should give the announcement a subject as well as the message.

All students enrolled on the course are automatically subscribed to the News forum which means that they will be emailed a copy of the announcement. Normally there is a delay of 30 minutes after the announcement has been posted to give you a chance to spot and rectify any mistakes before the email is sent.

If the message is urgent you can check the 'Mail now' box and the email will be sent immediately (There may be a few minutes delay).

You can then click on 'Edit' or 'Delete' to modify or remove the message.

Students cannot Edit, Delete or Reply to Announcements in the News Forum, although they can in other types of Discussion forum.

The latest 5 announcements are displayed in the 'Latest News' Block (N.B. the title will depend on what the 'News forum' is named, for example below on the School of Strings page it is called 'Strings News and Events'.)
